Archer Hotel | Napa, California

Crafted in Napa Valley just like the famous wines that are created here, the five-story Archer is a modern luxury boutique that features 183 lux guest suites, including 39 with private balconies overlooking downtown Napa.

The exterior features a modern Napa Style architecture which originates from the beauty and physical character of the valley. The geometric forms of the façade reflect the order and rhythm of the vineyards. Horizontal rows create balcony suites, while stone outdoor fireplaces create vertical posts as if they were holding up the grapevines themselves.

These stone fireplaces lead the eye to the roof top where they become cozy cabanas adorning the adjacent ledge lounging pool and spa. The Sky & Vine Rooftop Bar features comfy lounge seating, crackling stone fire pits, a canopy of potted olive trees with festoon lighting and breathtaking

panoramic views in this one-of-a-kind venue in all of Napa Valley.

The entry to the hotel is warm, inviting, and stunning as it opens into a skylit atrium. Native Napa stone and reclaimed teak bring a warm ambiance which welcomes guests and locals alike into what has become the most popular place to gather and enjoy Napa's finest wines.
